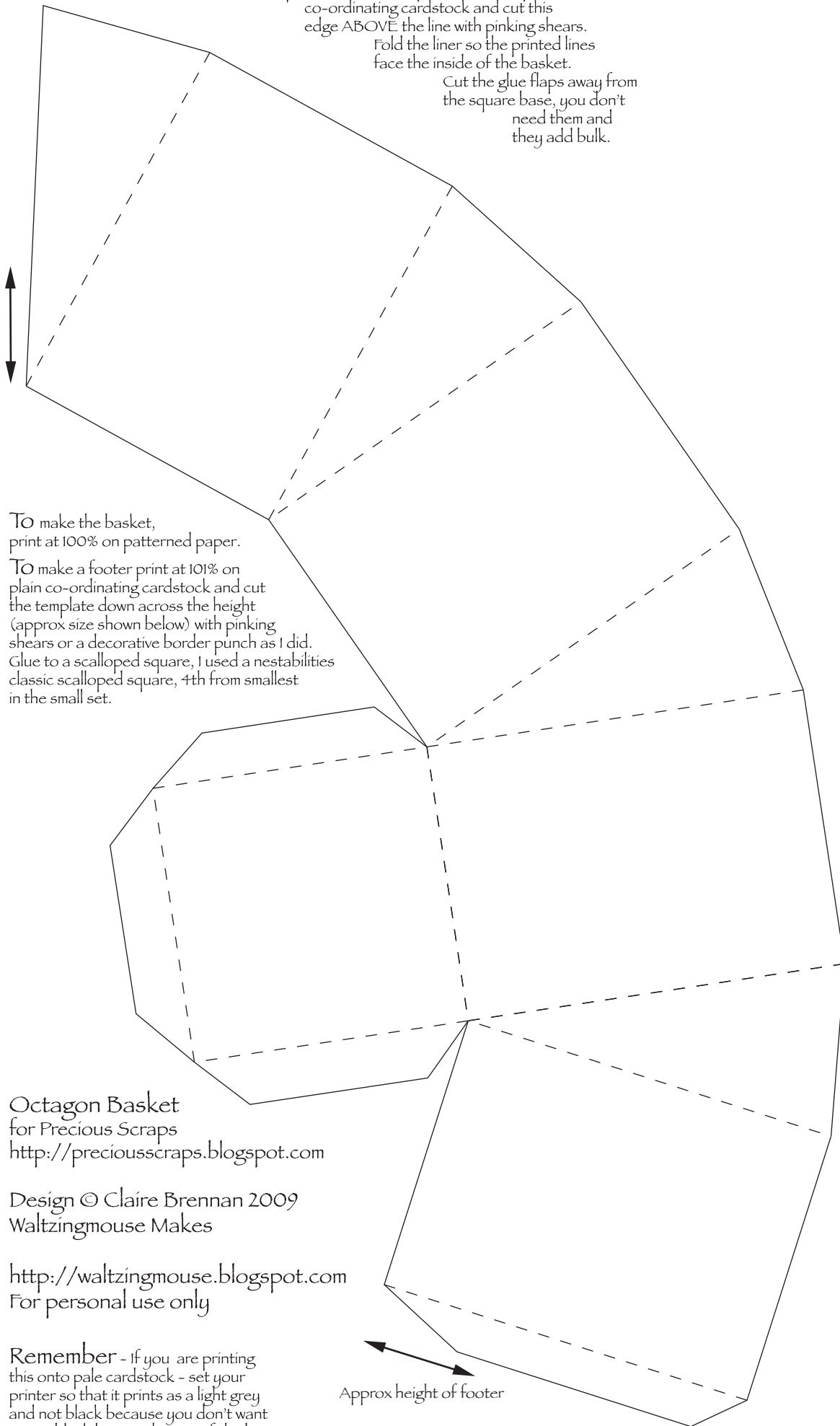


▼ To make a liner print at 99% on plain co-ordinating cardstock and cut this edge ABOVE the line with pinking shears.
Fold the liner so the printed lines face the inside of the basket.
Cut the glue flaps away from the square base, you don't need them and they add bulk.



To make the basket, print at 100% on patterned paper.

To make a footer print at 101% on plain co-ordinating cardstock and cut the template down across the height (approx size shown below) with pinking shears or a decorative border punch as I did. Glue to a scalloped square, 4th from smallest in the small set.

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Remember - If you are printing this onto pale cardstock - set your printer so that it prints as a light grey and not black because you don't want to see black lines at the top of the box.

▼ Cut the basket handle from along this edge of the cardstock - I cut a 3/8 inch strip from the full height of the cardstock and trim to desired length. I matted mine on a strip of plain cardstock
