

Strawberry Box & Tag Tutorial

Supply list:

- Big Shot
- Fun Flowers Bigz L Die
- Petal Cone Bigz L Die
- Perfect Polka Dots Embossing Folder
- 27" of Lucky Limeade 3/8" Ruffled Ribbon
- 1/8" hole punch
- Big Bite Crop-a-dile
- Sticky Strip
- Card Stock: Real Red, Early Espresso, Lucky Limeade
- Old Olive ink pad and sponge dauber



Using the Big Shot die cut 3 petal cone panels from Real Red card stock and emboss with the Perfect Polka Dot embossing folder.



Die cut 3 petal cones from Early Espresso card stock.



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Put Sticky Strip to all side tabs on the Real Red petal cones and adhere together. DO NOT adhere the 3rd tab yet.

Cut off the non-tabbed cone on the end as in the photo below.



Put Sticky Strip to all side tabs on the Early Espresso petal cones and adhere together. DO NOT adhere the 3rd tab yet. Cut the non-tabbed cone.

Cut the tops of the the Early Espresso petal cone panels in a wave as in the photo below.



Use Sticky Strip to adhere the Early Espresso to the Real Red petal cone panels.

Punch a 1/8" hole in each petal cone as shown below.



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Fold on all score marks and adhere the final tab to make the box.



Die cut the two Lucky Limeade flowers from the Fun Flowers Bigz L Die.

Sponge the edges with Old Olive.

Curl up the petals using a bone folder.

Punch a hole in the centers using a Crop-a-dile. I used the Big Bite Crop-a-dile to punch the hole in the larger flower.

Adhere the 2 flowers together so their petals alternate and the holes match up.

Set aside.

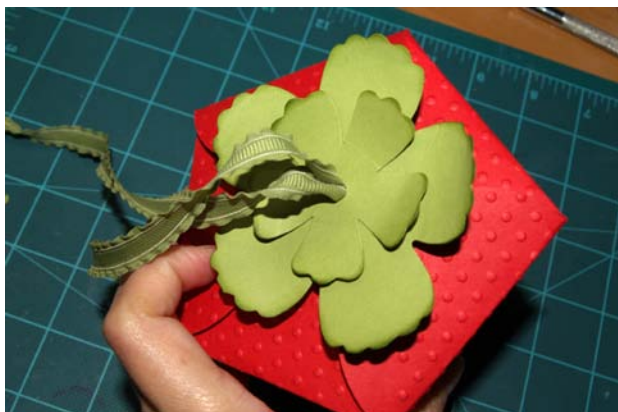


Follow the steps below to thread the ribbon through the holes.



Before tying the ends together put your treat in the box. Pull ends together to close the box.

Thread both ends of the ribbon through the flowers.



Tie the ribbon firmly in a bow.



Strawberry Tag

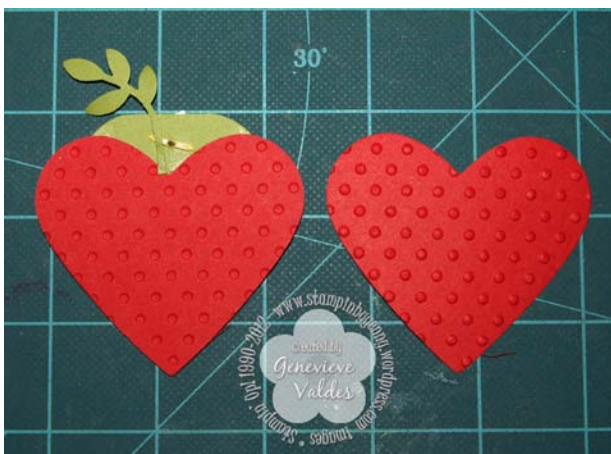
Supplies:

- Big Shot
- Heart Framelits
- Retired 5-Petal Flower Punch (you can substitute with scallop circle punch)
- Boho Blossoms Punch
- Jewelry Tag Punch
- Bird Builder Punch (for leaves at top of strawberry)
- Perfect Polka Dots Embossing Folder
- Retired Hemp Twine
- 1/8" hole punch
- 3/16" Daffodil Delight brad
- Real Red ink pad
- Tiny Tags Stamp Set
- Snail
- Card Stock: Real Red, Early Espresso, Lucky Limeade, Whisper White



Die cut 2 Real Red hearts using the 3rd largest heart in the Heart Framelits set. One heart is for the front and one for the back.

Emboss the hearts with the Perfect Details Embossing Folder.

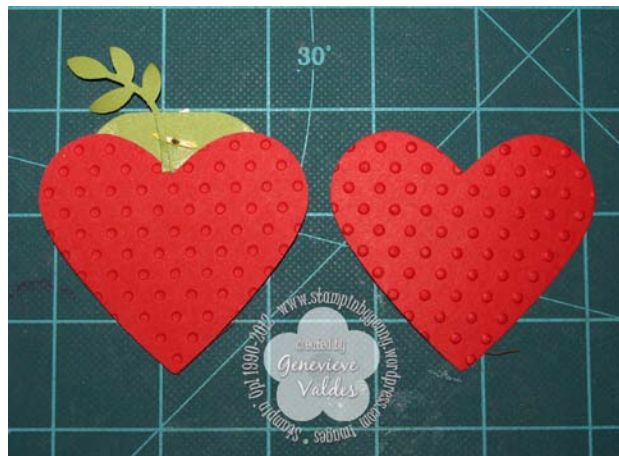


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- Punch one branch using the Bird Builder punch.
- Punch two flowers using the Boho Blossoms punch.
- Punch two 5-Petal flower and cut leaving 3 petals. You can also use the Scallop Circle punch to form the green top of the strawberry. You'll need two of these for the front and back of the tag. Adhere it to the top of the strawberry heart then
- Punch a hole for the twine then punch another hole for the brad.
- Adhere both Whisper White flowers and punch a hole in the center for the brad.
- Put the brad through the Whisper White flowers and attach to the top of the strawberry.
- Cut two Early Espresso bottoms with a wavy top and adhere to the front and the back of the strawberry.
- Stamp friends with Real Red ink and die cut with the Jewelry tag punch and adhere underneath the white flowers.



Back of strawberry tag

Put twine through the hole and attach to the top of the strawberry box.
